CAUSE OF MINOR SPILL: After the blockage was removed, it was determined that the cause of this minor spill was grease and roots. There are no commercial grease sources upstream from this location and residential grease is not regulated.

ESTIMATED VOLUME DISCHARGED: 3,120 gallons
(Please note that this quantity is only a calculated estimation of the volume of sewage that spilled from our system. More sewage may have escaped the system.)

RECEIVING WATERS: Ditch feeding Rocky Creek

SERVICE BASIN AFFECTED: Lower Rocky Creek

CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN TO MITIGATE OR TO REDUCE ADVERSE EFFECTS: Debris has been removed from the area and the affected area is being disinfected with lime.

SPILL STATUS: The blockage has been removed; sewage is no longer escaping.

CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN TO PREVENT FUTURE SPILL: This line is scheduled to be cleaned with grease emulsifier and televised. It will also be added to the weekly Hot Spot Inspection list and chemically treated for root control.
