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MINOR SPILL REPORT TO EPD

DATE OF MINOR SPILL: Friday, September 8, 2017 12:25pm – 3:00pm

REPORT SUBMITTED: Thursday, September 14, 2017

LOCATION OF MINOR SPILL: [2034 Napier Avenue](#), MH ID 56500
(Please note that the address used is a reference for the location of the manhole.)

CAUSE OF MINOR SPILL: After the blockage was removed, it was determined that the cause of this minor spill was grease. There are no commercial sources of grease upstream from this location and residential grease is not regulated.

ESTIMATED VOLUME DISCHARGED: 3,410 gallons
(Please note that this quantity is only a calculated estimation of the volume of sewage that spilled from our system. More sewage may have escaped the system.)

RECEIVING WATERS: Storm Drain

SERVICE BASIN AFFECTED: Riverside

CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN TO MITIGATE OR TO REDUCE ADVERSE EFFECTS: Debris has been removed from the area and the affected area is being disinfected with lime.

SPILL STATUS: The blockage was removed; sewage is no longer escaping.

SIGNS POSTED: Friday, September 8, 2017

CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN TO PREVENT FUTURE SPILL: This line is scheduled to be cleaned with grease emulsifier and televised. It will also be added to the weekly Hot Spot Inspection List.
