

INVITATION TO BID

MACON-BIBB, GEORGIA

Sealed Bids for furnishing all materials, labor, tools, equipment and appurtenances necessary for the installation of 2017 Macon-Bibb County Central Business District (CBD) Stormwater Rehabilitation (the "Project") will be received by the Macon-Bibb, Georgia ("Owner"), by and through the Owner's agent, the Macon Water Authority, at the Macon Water Authority, 790 Second Street, Second Floor Board Room, Macon, Georgia 31202 until 10:00 A. M., local time, November 21, 2017, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

The Project consists of furnishing all work necessary for cured in place pipe (CIPP) rehabilitation, spray cast rehabilitation, removal and replacement of storm drains, new storm drain manholes, rebuilding inlets, and associated erosion and sedimentation control. Cured in place pipe (CIPP) rehabilitation consists of approximately 30 linear feet of 12-Inch, 110 linear feet of 18-Inch, and 260 linear feet of 24-Inch storm sewer. Spray cast rehabilitation construction consists of approximately 2,000 linear feet of 30-Inch to 66-Inch storm sewer. New storm drain construction consists of 15-inch reinforced concrete piping with an approximate total length of 50 feet and 18-inch reinforced concrete piping with an approximate total length of 75 feet. Project will also include necessary miscellaneous drainage structure reconstruction and pavement replacement.

The Project will be awarded in one Contract. Fifty-one percent (51%) of the Work under the Contract Documents must be self-performed by the General Contractor. The Project will be awarded by base bid on a lump sum, fixed price basis for the performance and completion of all Work required by the Contract Documents.

The Contract Documents include, but may not be limited to, the Instructions to Bidders, the Contract Agreement, the General Conditions, the Drawings, the Specifications and the forms of Bid Bond, Performance Bond, and Payment Bond. The Bid Form is included with the Bidding Documents. Bidding Documents, consisting of Drawings, Project Manual and sections required to be submitted with the Bid Form, may be ordered by contacting David Bishop at Barge, Waggoner, Sumner and Cannon, Inc., by email david.bishop@bwsc.net or by phone (706) 321-4583. The cost of the Contract Documents is \$250.00, non-refundable, for each set. No partial sets will be sold. Bidders must meet the requirements set forth below in order to be eligible to submit a bid:

1. The Bidder must purchase the Contract Documents from Barge, Waggoner, Sumner and Cannon, Inc.

2. The Bidder must attend the Pre-Bid Meeting located at 790 Second Street, Second Floor Board Room, Macon, Georgia 31202 at 10:00 A. M., local time, November 7, 2017.

If the bid amount exceeds \$25,000, the Bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond in the amount of 10% of the Bid, prepared on the form of Bid Bond that is part of the Contract Documents, duly executed by the Bidder as principal and having as surety thereon a surety company licensed to do business in the State of Georgia and listed in the latest issue of U.S. Treasury Circular 570.

Bidders must comply with the Minority Participation Requirements specified in the Instructions to Bidders.

The Bidder shall affix to the outside of its Bid envelope the Bidder's Georgia Utility Contractor License Number. A license number of a Utility Manager or a subcontractor is insufficient, and any Bid that fails to affix to the outside of its Bid envelope the Bidder's Georgia Utility Contractor License Number may be rejected.

The successful Bidder for this Project shall be required to furnish a Performance Bond and Payment Bond, satisfactory to the Owner and the Agent, each in the amount of 100 % of the Contract Price, if the Contract Price will exceed \$25,000.

Employment of Local Businesses and Contractors: It is the desire of the Owner that local businesses, including minorities and disadvantaged subcontractors, be given the opportunity to participate on the various parts of the Work.

The Owner's encouragement of participation of minority and locally owned businesses and contractors is not intended to restrict or limit competitive bidding or to increase the cost of the Work. The Owner supports a healthy, free market system that seeks to include responsible local businesses and provide ample opportunities for local business growth and development.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids. The Owner reserves the right to waive informalities and technicalities.
