Rates/Fees for Public Fishing at Javors Lucas Lake

To offset the cost of staff and security, which is present at Javors Lucas Lake during the hours the reservoir is open to the public, as well as other expenses for maintenance and operation of the facility for public fishing, the MWA charges anglers or visitors a nominal fee for parking and access.

The MWA has the following rates/fees for fishing/boating at Javors Lucas Lake:

- * A seasonal pass to fish by boat is \$100.
- * A seasonal pass to fish from the shore is \$50.
- * A daily pass to fish by boat is \$10.
- * A daily pass to fish from the shore is \$5.

- * Note: the MWA does not accept credit cards as a payment option for public fishing.

- * Note: no gas-powered boats are allowed on Javors Lucas Lake, due to state and MWA regulations for public access to drinking water reservoirs. Only boats with electric or trolling motors are allowed for fishing.
