MWA Rules and Regulations for Boating and Fishing

Fishing on the MWA's Javors Lucas Lake is governed by the guidelines laid out by the Georgia Department of Natural Resources (DNR), Wildlife Resources Division provisions, which can be accessed on their Web site at www.georgiawildlife.com/fishing/regulations.

While fishing on Javors Lucas Lake, the number of guests per boat is limited to its rated capacity. No more than two (2) poles per person, but landing nets may be used to land fish legally caught.

In addition, these rules and regulations for boating and fishing on Javors Lucas Lake also apply:

- Operation of boats is limited to fishing boats propelled by paddles, oars, or electric motors.
- No boat equipped with or containing a diesel or gasoline motor shall be allowed on Javors Lucas Lake.
- Life preservers must be available for each boat occupant – no exceptions.
- All boats will return to the launch area upon the sounding of an air horn.

Visitors to Javors Lucas Lake are NOT allowed to:

- Swim in the reservoir.
- Possess or consume alcoholic beverages while on Macon Water Authority property, which includes Javors Lucas Lake.
- Fish with any gear other than a pole and line, or fish with more than two poles and lines per person.
- Use or possess live game fish for bait.
- Park a vehicle at any place other than designated areas.
- Drive or otherwise operate a vehicle on any road posted "closed" to vehicular access, drive around a closed gate or cable blocking a road, or drive on any road that is receiving maintenance for the purpose of vehicular access.

- Fish within 100 feet of concrete structures in Javors Lucas Lake.
- Possess firearms, pets or glass containers.
- Clean or cook fish while on Macon Water Authority property at Javors Lucas Lake.
- Litter or disturb the grounds.
- NOTE: Persons under 18 years of age may not enter or remain on MWA property unless supervised and accompanied by an adult (person of 18 years of age or older).

Daily Possession Limits

Possession limits for fish caught on Georgia waters, including Javors Lucas Lake, are set by the state Department of Natural Resources (DNR), Wildlife Resources Division.
