CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN TO PREVENT FUTURE OVERFLOW: The details of this overflow have been forwarded to our Grease Management team for further investigation. The line is scheduled to be cleaned with grease emulsifier and the manhole is scheduled to be repaired. This sewer main will be televised after the manhole repair has been completed. This location has been added to the weekly Hot Spot Inspection list for monitoring.
