MWA Warehouse

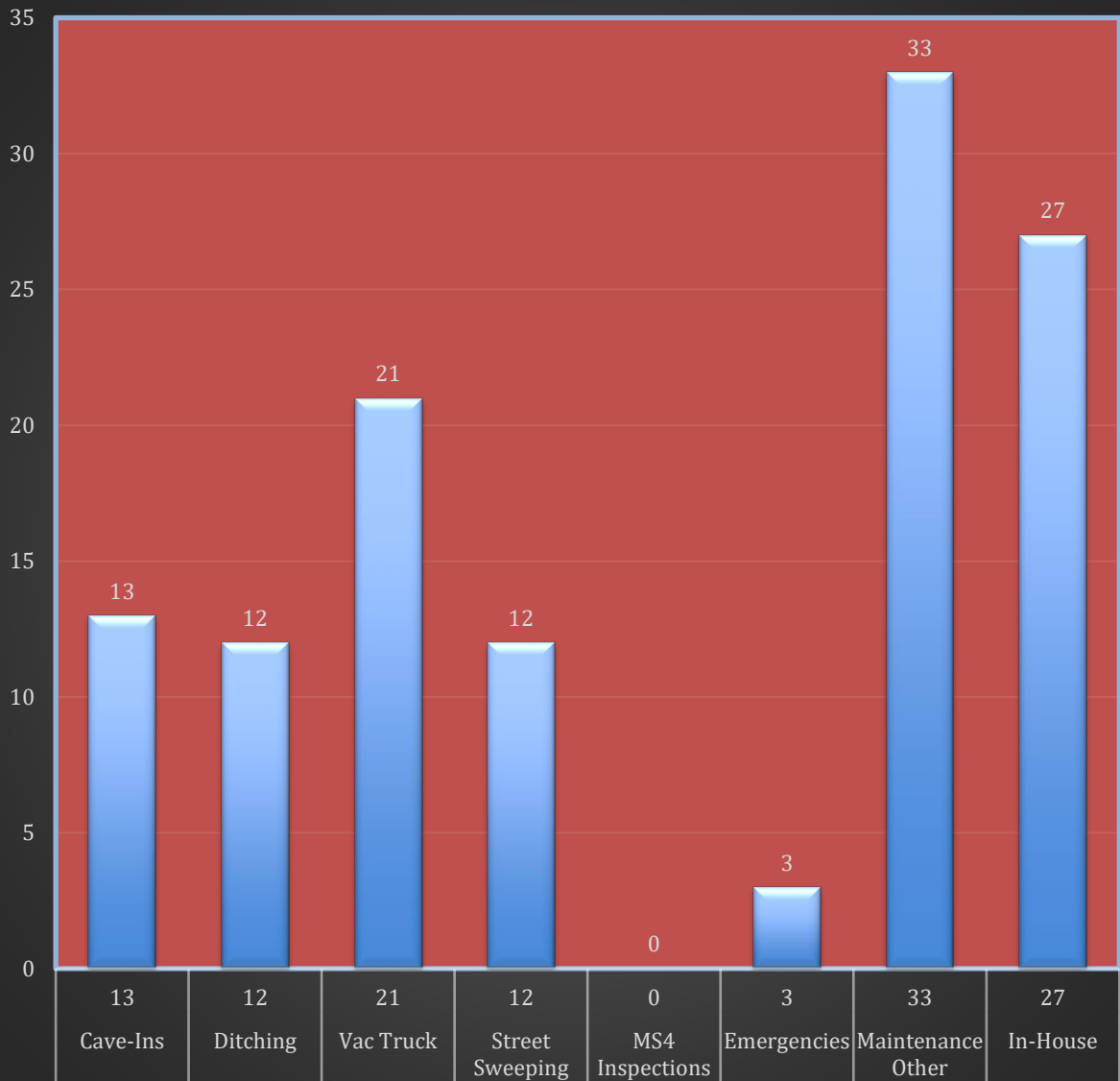
