**CAUSE OF MINOR SPILL:** After removing the blockage, we determined that the minor spill was caused by grease and rags in the sewer main. No commercial sources of grease have been identified upstream from the spill location.

**ESTIMATED VOLUME DISCHARGED:** 2,220 gallons  
*(Please note that this quantity is only a calculated **estimation** of the volume of sewage that spilled from our system. More sewage may have escaped the system.)*

**RECEIVING WATERS:** Ditch feeding Vineville Branch

**SERVICE BASIN AFFECTED:** Riverside Basin

**WRF SERVICE AREA NPDES PERMIT:** GA0024538

**CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN TO MITIGATE OR TO REDUCE ADVERSE EFFECTS:** Debris has been removed from the area. The affected area has also been sprayed with an enzyme treatment for organic waste called Bio-Bug.

**SPILL STATUS:** The blockage has been removed; Sewage is no longer escaping.

**SIGNS POSTED:** Monday, October 27, 2025

**CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN TO PREVENT FUTURE SPILL:** The details of this spill have been forwarded to our Grease Management team for further investigation. The line is scheduled to be cleaned with a grease emulsifier and televised. It will also be added to the Hotspot Inspection list for monitoring.
