MWA Warehouse

The contractor is currently installing a new front door at the entrance of the warehouse, and BTV is working on a badge reader for the back door. We continue to implement new processes in the Warehouse to better serve MWA employees and contractors more efficiently with fewer interruptions.

The warehouse staff has completed **154** work orders and charged **294** GL codes, totaling \$231,027.06 in inventory transactions for the warehouse in January 2026, excluding Stormwater (\$3,793.63) and \$2,892.79 to Fleet.
