CAUSE OF MINOR SPILL: After removing the blockage, we determined that the minor spill was caused by grease in the sewer main. A commercial source of grease has been identified upstream from the spill location.

ESTIMATED VOLUME DISCHARGED: 2,440 gallons
*(Please note that this quantity is only a calculated **estimation** of the volume of sewage that spilled from our system. More sewage may have escaped the system.)*

RECEIVING WATERS: Vineville Branch

SERVICE BASIN AFFECTED: Riverside

WRF SERVICE AREA NPDES PERMIT: GA0024538

CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN TO MITIGATE OR TO REDUCE ADVERSE EFFECTS: Debris has been removed from the area. The affected area has also been sprayed with an enzyme treatment for organic waste called Bio-Bug.

SPILL STATUS: Sewage is no longer escaping.

SIGNS POSTED: Wednesday, April 22, 2026

CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN TO PREVENT FUTURE SPILL: This line is scheduled for cleaning and CCTV inspection. The details of this spill have been forwarded to our Grease Management team for further investigation, and it will be added to our Hot Spot Inspection list for monitoring.
