BTV is working on the fire alarm system. Quotes have been received for the bathroom renovations and outside wall repair. We continue to implement new processes in the Warehouse to better serve MWA employees and contractors more efficiently with fewer interruptions.

The warehouse staff has completed **114** work orders and charged **228** GL codes, totaling \$210,445.02 in inventory transactions for the warehouse in March 2026, excluding Stormwater \$6,263.00 and \$4,337.21 to Fleet.
