MWA Warehouse

BTV has completed work on the fire alarm system. Warehouse lighting has been approved and will begin ASAP. We continue to implement new processes in the Warehouse to better serve MWA employees and contractors more efficiently with fewer interruptions.

The warehouse staff has completed **141** work orders and charged **314** GL codes, totaling \$345,237.51 in inventory transactions for the warehouse in April 2026, excluding Stormwater \$16,502.56 and \$3,142.05 to Fleet.
