**LOCATION OF MINOR SPILL:** [4620 South Stratford Oaks Drive](#) – Main ID: 10737  
(Please note that the address used is a reference for the location of the sewer main.)

**CAUSE OF MINOR SPILL:** After removing the blockage, we determined that the minor spill was caused by grease and rags in the sewer main. No commercial sources of grease have been identified upstream from the spill location.

**ESTIMATED VOLUME DISCHARGED:** 2,540 gallons  
(Please note that this quantity is only a calculated **estimation** of the volume of sewage that spilled from our system. More sewage may have escaped the system.)

**RECEIVING WATERS:** Savage Creek

**SERVICE BASIN AFFECTED:** Sabbath Creek

**WRF SERVICE AREA NPDES PERMIT:** GA0024538

**CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN TO MITIGATE OR TO REDUCE ADVERSE EFFECTS:** Debris has been removed from the area. The affected area has also been sprayed with an enzyme treatment for organic waste called Bio-Bug.

**SPILL STATUS:** Sewage is no longer escaping.

**SIGNS POSTED:** Sunday, June 7, 2026

**CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN TO PREVENT FUTURE SPILL:** This line is scheduled for cleaning and CCTV inspection. The details of this spill have been forwarded to our Grease Management team for further investigation, and we will continue to monitor this area.
