CAUSE OF MINOR SPILL: After removing the blockage, we determined that the minor spill was caused by roots in the sewer main.

ESTIMATED VOLUME DISCHARGED: 6,800 gallons
(Please note that this quantity is only a calculated **estimation** of the volume of sewage that spilled from our system. More sewage may have escaped the system.)

RECEIVING WATERS: Ditch feeding Bowman Creek

SERVICE BASIN AFFECTED: Corbin Avenue

WRF SERVICE AREA NPDES PERMIT: GA0024538

CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN TO MITIGATE OR TO REDUCE ADVERSE EFFECTS:

The blockage has been cleared, and debris has been removed from the area. The affected area has also been sprayed with an enzyme treatment for organic waste called Bio-Bug.

SPILL STATUS: Sewage is no longer escaping.

SIGNS POSTED: Tuesday, July 7, 2026

CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN TO PREVENT FUTURE SPILL: This line is scheduled for cleaning and CCTV inspection. It will also be added to our Hot Spot Inspection list for monitoring and is scheduled to be chemically treated for root intrusion.
