MWA Warehouse

Warehouse lighting has been completed. Preparing to make outside wall repairs. We continue to implement new processes in the Warehouse to better serve MWA employees and contractors more efficiently with fewer interruptions.

The warehouse staff has completed **131** work orders and charged **227** GL codes, totaling \$295,264.97 in inventory transactions for the warehouse for June 2026, excluding Stormwater \$15,062.08 and \$3,877.60 to fleet.
